


TROFFER Size: 2'x2', 2'x4'

1. REMOVING FIXTURE FROM PACKAGING




- A. Ensure "THIS SIDE UP" is visible and packaging is oriented in the designated
- B. Using CLEAN work gloves, carefully lift fixture out of packaging materials while holding on to opposite ends of fixture.


NOTE: AVOID CONTACT WITH LENSES

2. INSTALLING FIXTURE TO GRID








- A. Gently rotate fixture housing and angle into ceiling grid.
- B. Rest fixture inside the center of the ceiling grid prior to securing tabs.
- C. Ensure all fixtures are oriented in the same direction or as intended by others.

3. SECURING FIXTURE TO GRID





degree and align with two sides of grid.
